ORDER

PITMAN, United States Magistrate Judge:

A conference having been held in this matter on February 16, 2017, during which I heard oral argument concerning the motions of Keith Richards, David Byrne and David Israelite (the "Non-Party Witnesses") to quash subpoenas seeking deposition testimony, after hearing from counsel for all sides, for the reasons stated on the record in open court, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Non-Party Witnesses' motions to quash subpoenas for deposition testimony are granted to the extent that any questioning of them shall be done by written questions and shall be limited to a total of 25 questions, to be answered under oath or an affitimation pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746 . Subparts shall count as separate questions. The Non-Party Witnesses shall have

30 days to answer of object to the questions.


Questions to which valid objections are made will count against the 25 question limit. This Order is without prejudice to a further application by defendants to conduct the oral examination of the Non-Party Witnesses if the answers to the written questions demonstrate that such discovery is appropriate.

2. Israelite's and Richards' requests for fees are denied.

The Clerk of the Court is respectfully requested to close Docket Items 71 and 74.
